Romans 5: 1-8

Peace and hope

5 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God. ³ Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; ⁴ perseverance, character; and character, hope. ⁵ And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

⁶ You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. ⁷ Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. ⁸ But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

- ³⁵ Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and illness.

- ⁹ 'Do not get any gold or silver or copper to take with you in your belts ¹⁰ no bag for the journey or extra shirt or sandals or a staff, for the worker is worth his keep. ¹¹ Whatever town or village you enter, search there for some worthy person and stay at their house until you leave. ¹² As you enter the home, give it your greeting. ¹³ If the home is deserving, let your peace rest on it; if it is not, let your peace return to you. ¹⁴ If anyone will not welcome you or listen to your words, leave that home or town and shake the dust off your feet. ¹⁵ Truly I tell you, it will be more bearable for Sodom and Gomorrah on the day of judgement than for that town.
- ¹⁶ 'I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves. ¹⁷ Be on your guard; you will be handed over to the local councils and be flogged in the synagogues. ¹⁸ On my account you will be brought before governors and kings as witnesses to them and to the Gentiles. ¹⁹ But when they arrest you, do not worry about what to say or how to say it. At that time you will be given what to say, ²⁰ for it will not be you speaking, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you.
- ²¹ 'Brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child; children will rebel against their parents and have them put to death. ²² You will be hated by everyone because of me, but the one who stands firm to the end will be saved. ²³ When you are persecuted in one place, flee to another. Truly I tell you, you will not finish going through the towns of Israel before the Son of Man comes.

Guidance on re-opening churches

Following the announcement by the government last week have received significant amounts of advice from the central Church and diocese about reopening Church. In the light of this advice we are able to make the following announcement:

Private Prayer – Church opening

We are currently putting in place plans to open Stranton Church for Private Prayer only (NOT Services) from Sunday 21 June from **9.30am – 11.30am.**

There will be no public services at or streamed from Stranton Church (or any other Church) for the next few weeks at least, although worship "streaming" on Facebook and website (http://www.stranton-church.org.uk) will continue.

When the Church is opened, everyone attending is requested to consider the safety of others wanting to attend.

The Church Wardens, PCC and clergy have a responsibility to ensure we keep everyone safe therefore:

- Please do not attend if you are "self isolating".
- Please keep two metres (six feet) between yourself and others, except for your own household members.
- Please use hand sanitiser provided when you enter and leave the building.
- Please allow the welcomer to record your name and contact details, for contact tracing.
- Please follow the directions you are given including where to sit in the Church building.
- Please try to avoid the need to use the toilet if at all possible, and follow cleaning instructions if you have to
- Initially this arrangement will be for 3 weeks.

We are not proposing to open Stranton Church mid-week because the planned alterations may start soon, to make our church building more accessible once we are through the Pandemic. Pew cushions are also being removed to make it easier to clean. Local authority and School regulations mean we cannot hold private prayer in the School for Burbank members .
